The University Ridge Golf Course is a public golf course and the official home course to the University of Wisconsin men's and women's golf teams.

The wide open front nine rolls through a preserved prairie and marshland, while the first six holes of the back nine are cut out of a dense Wisconsin woodland. The 554-yard signature 16th hole, features three fairways and 16 bunkers.

Located adjacent to University Ridge Golf Course is the Thomas Zimmer Championship Course which will host this fall the 2018 NCAA Cross Country Championship.
